1. Authority

The addendum has been established under the authority granted by section 22, subsection 2 and 3 of Ministerial Order no. 1062 of 7th July 2016 on University Examinations and Grading (the Examination Order) and section 18 of Ministerial Order no. 1061 of 7th July 2016 on Bachelor's and Master's Programmes at Universities (the University Programme Order).

2. Assessment of examinations

Examinations are either internal or external.

(2). Internal written examinations are assessed by a member of the university's teaching staff (internal examiner) appointed by the university from among the teaching staff at the University of Copenhagen.

(3). External written examinations are assessed by an internal examiner and by one or more external examiners appointed by the Danish Agency for Higher Education (external examination).

(4). Oral examinations are assessed by several examiners appointed among the teaching staff at the University of Copenhagen or by external examination.

(5). The Bachelor's project, Master's thesis and Master's project are assessed by external examination.

3. Electives at Bachelor's programmes

The Bachelor's programme consists of a main subject of 135 ECTS (incl. Propedeutics) and must be combined with an elective of 45 ECTS within or outside the main subject.

4. Commencement

The addendum comes into effect on 1 September 2017.

5. Approval

The addendum is approved by the Dean of the Faculty of Humanities, 28 August 2017.
